Farmers' markets play a vital role in our local food system by providing viable market opportunities for farmers, incubating local food entrepreneurs and fostering direct relationships between eaters and farmers.

Did you know?

91 cents of each dollar spent in conventional food markets goes to suppliers, processors, middlemen and marketers; while farmers earn only 9 cents. Farmers who sell direct at local farmers' markets are able to keep 80-90 cents of each dollar.

Selling locally, farmers can reduce their distribution, packaging and advertising costs and offer us fresher, more affordable food. Prosperous farmers keep farming and operate viable businesses that enhance our communities and strengthen our local food system.
